THE ARGUMENT

Speed up one part of a system and the constraint moves to the next one. AI sped up the doing; the directing became the bottleneck. For a century, organizations were designed around roles that produce work — analyze, draft, review, execute. AI now absorbs a large share of that. So, the constraint is no longer capacity. It is clarity: knowing which competing priority actually matters and being willing to own the answer. The gap between what AI can do and what an organization gets from it is not a technology gap. It is a leadership bottleneck.
